September Right of the Month: Transfer and Discharge

A resident and his or her representative are entitled to thirty days advance notice of transfer or discharge and the reasons for it. However, transfer or discharge may be on shorter notice when the health or safety of the resident is endangered, the resident's health improves enough to allow for a more immediate discharge, immediate transfer or discharge is needed due to urgent medical needs or the resident has not resided in the facility for a period of at least thirty days.
